The consultant for building the permanent campus has been appointed. The land use permission from RAJUK has been obtained and the architectural design approved by the authority. This opens the development scenario of Prime University. By this time, the selection of the construction firm is underway. All these make the progress of construction work of the permanent campus a reality long sought for.

University of Science and Technology Professor Dr. Abul Hossain Sikder was the Chief Guest at the seminar. The seminar covered a broad range of topics including comparative and theoretical approaches to research and research methods. The key speaker Professor Dr. Kanchan Roy highlighted that research is a dynamic process and its objective is to contribute to the existing knowledge. He also mentioned how to collect qualitative, quantitative data and the process of writing research report.

The Chief Guest Professor Dr. Abul Hossain Sikder focused on the value of research for the development of University faculties in their advanced studies and encouraged the faculty members to sharpen their observation and thought by involving themselves in the field of research. While delivering the

Khondakar Ashraf Hossain, a paragon of genius died on the 16th June 2013. He started working in the Department of English in Prime University on 10.11.2005. He was a mentor, a guide, a guru, an advisor and a well wisher for the students of Prime University and eventually the University itself. He was born on 4th January 1950 in the Joynagar village of Jamalpur Sadar Upazila, Jamalpur. He was a distinguished professor and chairman of the Department of English, Dhaka University. He was serving as the Vice Chancellor, Jatiya Kabi Kazi Nazrul Islam University while his premature death snatched him away from his dear and near ones.

A leading poet, essayist, translator and editor, he wrote more than eighteen books. His poems have been translated into English, German, French, Telegu and Hindi. He edited and published literary magazine "Ekobingsho."

The members of BOT, the teachers, students and others of the University condoled his death. A mourning meeting was organized by the Department of English, Prime University on 21.6.13.

We also mourn the death of **AZM Nasimuzzaman**, former Deputy Registrar and **Golam Ahad** an LLM student of Prime University. The PU family expresses heartfelt condolence and prays for their departed souls.

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
