Annual General Meeting of Board of Governors of Prime Foundation



These nonlinear effects can be used for optical signal processing to improve the network systems. The speaker showed how optical signal is processed using nonlinear phenomena.

This panel is generally known as External Peer Review team (EPRT). In response, the peer review team shares internationally accepted standard and good practices, their experiences and observations as the outcomes of an onsite visit and critical review.

The visit by the review team gives the program offering entity an opportunity to discuss and find ways of consolidating and improving the academic environment for the accreditation of the program. To be an enlisted as an External Peer Reviewer, Certain criteria are requied to be fulfilled by the person involved in quality assurance process. Md Jahidul Azad, Additional Director of IQAC and Assistant Professor of Dept. of English brought glory for the university on being enlisted as an External Peer Reviewer by Quality Assurance Unit (QAU), UGC on 30.04.2018.
