Ph.D. obtained: Mr. Zahid Rafique has obtained Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Law from Institute of Bangladesh Studies (IBS), University of

Rajshahi, a prestigious research institute in Bangladesh. The degree was conferred on him at the 434th syndicate meeting of the University of Rajshahi. The field of his research was "Company Law as Administered in Bangladesh with Emphasis on Shares and Debentures". His supervisor

was Dr. M. Habibur Rahman, Professor, Department of Law and Justice, Rajshahi University a renowned scholar on the Law of the Sea and Max Planck Visiting Scholar at Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law, Germany. Mr. Zahid Rafique hails from village Cher Jamira, Police Station Sarishabari, District Jamalpur. His father's name is Dr. Md. Rafiqul Islam. He works as a Lecturer, Department of Law, Prime University.

Mr. Palash Chandra Karmaker an Assistant Professor in the Department of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering of Prime University, an M.Sc. from Rajshahi University, has completed another M.Sc. degree in Communication Engineering under the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering from United International University (UIU). ### A Documentary Film on Bangabandhu's Home Coming Day Displayed

January 10 is a historic day as it is the Home Coming Day of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. The day is remembered as a memorable day in our national history. The nation observes the day paying rich tributes to the great leader. In observance of the day Prime University displayed a documentary film in the University premises on January 10, 2011 at 3:00 pm. The documentary was produced by an organization named "Satyanneshan".

On this day in 1972, Bangabandhu returned home after nine and a half months of captivity in Pakistan jail. Pakistan army arrested him on March 25, 1971 from his Dhanmondi residence during the late-night crackdown of Pakistan occupation forces on the people of Bangladesh (then East Pakistan). The glorious history was highlighted in the documentary film. Through watching the film the present generation will be aware of the history of the Father of the Nation as well as of birth of the independent Bangladesh.

Forty years back, we were liberated from Pakistan. We are celebrating 16th December on our free soil with fervour and solemnity."
